- Overall condition of greens is in a good place. We continue to head in the right direction with our overall long term goals and objectives.
- Over 200 plugs have been put into areas on greens where needed over recent weeks including just on 100 into the 18th green alone. This will be ongoing over the next 2-3 months.

Seeded void and plug work...



- Small voids of greens have continued to receive a light top-dress by hand to assist with in filling, particularly where we have had good success with seed germination.
- All greens were 8mm solid tined (20/5 & 21/5) This is an ongoing monthly maintenance practice.
- The 7th green continues to improve each week as the young bent grass matures.
- The 12th green is showing an excellent response to light fertiliser applications and twice be inter seeded with bent grass. It will continue to be given a rest from play as required.

TEES/COLLARS/APRONS

- Weaker tees with thinner coverage of grass have been given a light pre dormancy fertilise. (20/5)
- Herbicide application to couch tees for kikuyu and crab grass control (30/4)
- Mowing of tees is now back to twice a week.

FAIRWAYS

- Foliar fertiliser application to all fairways (6th May)
- Mowing back to twice a week with reduced growth



BUNKERS

- Full bunker edge, weed and tidy was completed in preparation for Camden Cup

MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

- Raise sprinkler head at front right of 16th green to eliminate wet area in low point
- Trim all sprinkler heads
- Trim plates on tees
- Snip, mow and paint all hazards
- Sprinkler head repair work on 4th fairway
- Path work on 4th and 15th holes

WINTER JOB LIST

This list is a guide for the winter months. Items will be added and removed as deemed appropriate...

- Tree Maintenance (raise canopies, trim limbs, remove dead small trees)
- Path work and maintenance
- Full bunker audit including addition of new sand where required
- Refurbish and upgrade course furniture
- Paint distance posts
- Replace, repair, install traffic bollards
- Garden maintenance
- Clean up dam and pond edges and surrounds
- Full irrigation audit
- Addition of sprinkler heads where necessary
- Ongoing plug and turf work
- Upgrade and renew nursery
- Full tidy and clean out of old shed area
- Spray and check integrity of boundary fences
- Tidy up native areas
