GREENS

- Mowing height returned to 3.5mm (25/2) after 2 weeks of extremely wet weather.
- Greens have been getting rolled more often the past 2 weeks with cooler nights now upon us and less stressful conditions for the greens.
- Preventative applications are up to date.
- Greens renovations – Sunday 15th (3pm) to Tuesday 17th March
- Following greens renovations, the height of cut will gradually be reduced now that the climatic stress of the summer months has gone.

TEES & FAIRWAYS

- Tees and fairway are in a healthy condition and growing well.
- Soluble fertiliser and growth regulator applied to all fairways and approaches (3/3)
- Kikuyu spot sprayed in couch tees and surrounds. Also 8th and 9th green surrounds



BUNKERS

- Bunker maintenance ongoing

MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

- Round up spraying on mulch beds, mounding, tree bases, hazards etc is ongoing.
- Several fallen branches in recent weeks.
- Playground/Outdoor area tidied up, levelled, growing medium added and turf to be laid (13/3)
- Whipper snipping of miscellaneous areas is ongoing
