## **GREENS**

---

- Mowing height is currently at 2.75mm.
- Greens are being rolled 2-3 times a week now that conditions are favourable.
- Plug work done in areas of bird damage from the summer months. Damage to greens from corella's has ceased with the onset of the cooler weather and shorter days
- Greens (all except 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup>) were 8mm solid tined (18/5) to allow some oxygen into the soil profile and assist with water penetration during periods of heavy rainfall

## **TEES & FAIRWAYS**

---

- Tees and collars being mowed once a week; Fairways being mowed as needed
- Bar staff have been assisting on course with tee divots. Many thanks to Caitlyn, Tina and Stephanie
- Winter colour, fertiliser and selective herbicide application to all fairways and approaches (11/5)

## **BUNKERS**

---

- All bunkers edged, weeded and sand depths checked (18/5-20/5)

## **MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS**

---

- Round up spraying on mulch beds, mounding, tree bases, hazards etc is ongoing.
- Whipper snipping of miscellaneous areas is ongoing
- Cart paths edged
- Piles of soil dumped at 12<sup>th</sup> green surround and back of 14<sup>th</sup> tee will be shaped into mounding and new teeing area respectively
