- Mowing height is currently at 2.75mm.
- Greens are being rolled 3-4 times a week, walk mowed twice a week and triplex mowed once a week. Currently running nice and true with this regime.
- All greens given an 8mm needle tine (29/6)
- Vandalism to the 2nd green (7/7)
- Corella damage to 5th green (12/7)
- Winter maintenance granular fertiliser application (13/7)
- All greens have been given a second edging for encroaching warm season grass runners.
- Winter fungicide and foliar fertiliser programs are on schedule.

TEES & FAIRWAYS

- Tees and collars being mowed once a week; Fairways being mowed as needed
- Tees, particularly the par 3's are showing increased wear with a large volume of play and minimal growth and recovery.
- Needle tined some firmer tees (9th,11th,12th) and applied Gypsum to assist with drainage and compaction
- Tees sprayed with a follow up application of a post emergent herbicide for winter grass (18/7)

BUNKERS

- Bunker maintenance is ongoing
- Daily raking has been more frequent due to a large amount of play
- All bunker edges snipped and sprayed with non selective herbicide for grass weeds

MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

- Round up spraying on mulch beds, mounding, tree bases, hazards etc is ongoing.
- Whipper snipping of miscellaneous areas is ongoing
- Parramatta grass continues to be spot sprayed
- Ken Bellman has completed restoration work on all the sand boxes around the course. Staff have started sanding them back.
- Stump grinding has been carried out across the golf course.
