GREENS

- Mowing height is currently at 2.75mm and will remain so until greens renovations
- All greens lightly dusted prior to Club Championships (29/9)
- Focus is on a true surface for Club Championships with regular walk mowing and rolling. A light dusting will be applied next week (19/10) This will assist with trueness and firmness of the greens for final 2 rounds.
- Pesticide and nutrition programs are on schedule.



TEES & FAIRWAYS

- Tees and collars being mowed twice a week now with increased growth; Fairways now being mowed 2-3 times a week
- Fairways given a granular fertiliser application (29/9)
- Ongoing repair of tee divots
- 18th Fairway mini tined, lightly topdressed and fertilised (28/9)
- 10th Fairway given a light topdress in thin areas; This will continue as the weather continues to warm up and there is consistent growth



BUNKERS

- All bunkers edged and prepared for Club Championships (7/10)
- Sand continues to be added to bunkers where required. This and repair/removal of liner matting will continue to be ongoing



MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

- Round up spraying on mulch beds, mounding, tree bases, hazards etc is ongoing.
- Significant clean up was required after a wind storm went through on 25th September
- The new turf area in front of the 8th green is now in play. There are some small areas of GUR where the turf still hasn't quite completely knitted in.
- New mounding on the 12th hole is growing in well. The GUR has been altered slightly and part of the mounding is now in play. Please try and avoid driving carts through and over the mounding.
- All sprinkler heads trimmed.
- *Buxus* plants have gone in at the 3rd tee. This will provide a nice neat hedge as they grow in over time. The plants were kindly donated by Bob Zelesco.
