- Our greens are in good health as we lead into the cooler months.
- All greens are now at our final cutting height of 2.75mm for upcoming months.
- Greens are now being rolled on a regular basis.
- Bird damaged areas on the 11th and 16th greens have been plugged out.
- Nursery green has been stripped, enlarged, relevelled and seeded

TEES & FAIRWAYS

- Growth has been strong and consistent on tees, fairways and approaches. We are being kept busy with the mowing of all these surfaces to present them in good order.
- Height of cut on tees, collars and fairways were lifted due to wet and soft surfaces after the heavy rains but has since returned to normal cutting heights

- Bunker edging and trimming completed every 2-3 weeks to maintain presentation
- Bunker damage from heavy rain has occurred numerous times. Pumping and repair work have been a time consuming exercise in recent months.

MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

- Round up spraying on mulch beds, mounding, tree bases, hazards, fence lines etc is ongoing. Also, spot spraying of parramatta grass and paspalum is ongoing.
- Path remediation work is planned for the winter months
- New tee plates will be installed on tee boxes in the coming months due to most of the current ones being damaged or missing.
- Additional hours have been spent mowing rough and snipping due to the high rate of growth we have experienced in recent months on the backend of above average rainfall. Most of this is now caught up on and on a normal routine.
- Arthur Kelly is currently doing some new plantings around the course. New plantings will be staked and any tree that has a tree bag around it is also to be treated as a staked tree. Full relief is to be taken.
- Thank you to Peter Tanner and the group of volunteers for their assistance in cleaning the tee and sponsor signs on the course.
- New greenkeeper, Lindsay Hudson commenced work Tuesday 11th May. Lindsay is a member of the club and a competent golfer who will be a great addition to the team.
