GREENS

- Greens are in a nice healthy condition. Greens have been consistently firm and a desirable speed.
- All greens were given an 8mm solid tine (20/9) and rolled
- Nursery green has grown in very well and almost at 100% coverage and ready to use should the need arise.
- Putting green extension has been undertaken (20/9-22/9) Kikuyu turf was removed; herbicide sprayed on underlying material; fresh growing medium was added and shaped; seeded with bent grass and wheel tracked in.

TEES & FAIRWAYS

- Tees and fairway mowing are slowly increasing frequency
- Pre-emergent herbicide and wetting agent completed on all fairways for prevention of summer weed germination.
- Tees are slowly coming out of dormancy, particularly the couch tees and recovering from winter wear and tear.
- Turf from putting green extension was used for areas on the 5th, 14th and 18th fairways.

BUNKERS

- Bunker edging and trimming completed as required to maintain presentation

MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

- Round up spraying on mulch beds, mounding, tree bases, hazards, fence lines etc is ongoing.
- All sprinkler heads have been trimmed.
- A full irrigation performance audit has been carried out.
- All cart paths have been edged and tidied up.
- Lomandras have been removed on the mounding next to the practice hitting nets. This area has been reshaped with a new path to the 10th tee created. The mounds will be re planted and mulched creating a much more aesthetically pleasing and practical area incorporated to the practice area to 10th tee transition



- Path remediation has been done on several areas. A lot of the ends of cart paths had deteriorated. There are still some small ones to be done but the worst and larger path ends are now much improved.
