## NOTICE TO MEMBERS

**This programme book is correct at the time of printing but may be subject to changes by the Golf Committee.**

Any competitor desiring to enter a protest in connection with a match or competition shall do so in writing addressed to the Match Committee of the Day, before the competition is closed.

In the event of two or more players returning the same or equal scores in a competition the winner will be decided by a count back system (nett result), unless Golf NSW or Club Golf By-Laws specifies a play off to take place for the winner of the event (scratch result).

Where mixed events have been set down for play, a separate competition will be conducted for members not participating in the mixed event.

Members should look at the noticeboard and the whiteboard outside the Pro Shop before starting play for that day, as they should be aware of all notices and Local Rules. In particular, when preferred lies are used players should note requirement to mark ball prior to preferring.

A storm policy will be in place with an audible siren indicating suspension of play if electrical storms are in the area. A 2<sup>nd</sup> siren indicates play can resume. Should the storm result in heavy rain/flooded greens a siren will be used also to suspend play.

Members should check their handicap when entering their score into the computer. The player and marker must sign the scorecard before it is handed in.

For the 2022 calendar year the following playing handicaps apply for Men and Women;

<b>Handicap Divisions:</b>	<b>Men</b>
A Grade	+ to 12
B Grade	13 to 19
C Grade	20 to 36

<b>Handicap Divisions:</b>	<b>Women - Saturday</b>
A Grade	0 to 20
B Grade	21 to 29
C Grade	30 to 45

<b>Handicap Divisions:</b>	<b>Women - Wednesday</b>
A Grade	0 to 25
B Grade	26 to 32
C Grade	33 to 45

Handicap ranges will vary from time to time based on the number of players in each grade and division.

In fourball events there must be a clear indication of the scorer at each hole.

Members when practicing on the course are permitted to play 2 balls only. For further practice use the practice fairway (please

note you must hit up the hill towards the distance markers from the teeing area) and the 2 practice greens.

Members and visitors are not permitted to retrieve golf balls from the dams, unless retrieving your own golf ball or a member of your group during your round of golf. Only other exception is if contracted by the Pro Shop to do so. Any person found retrieving balls without permission will be escorted from the golf course.

When playing competition or practicing, or a social round on the course it is essential to carry and use a sand bucket and observe dress rules. Members wishing to play a social round of golf are reminded to book in at the Pro-Shop.

Members are required to report to the starter at least 15 minutes before hit off time. Failure to do so may be regarded as an infringement of local rule.

If members are unable to keep their booked in hit-off time they must ring and let the starter know of their late arrival so the hit-off times can be re-scheduled.

When a member withdraws from a competition within 24 hours of play or fails to attend, then that player shall pay a cancellation fee equal to the competition fee of the day.

Exemptions to the fee will only occur under the following circumstances:

- Notice to the starter prior to hit-off time and has work commitments.
- Notice to the starter prior to hit-off time and has medical problems.
- Notice to the starter prior to hit-off time and has family problems.
- Any player within a calendar year will be permitted a maximum of 3 exemptions, with excuse. After these 3 exemptions a cancellation fee will apply to all other failures to attend/play during that calendar year.

Players when called by the starter must make their way to the nominated teeing area.

All events, unless otherwise specified, are played using official Golf Australia handicaps. Results are determined using the daily handicap.

## HELPFUL HINTS FROM THE CAPTAINS

The following will make your game on the course, and your stay in the Clubhouse, a happier day for all concerned if you:-

- Keep an eye on the flight of your ball, walk to your ball and be ready to hit it, when fairway or green is clear.
- Always be prepared to play ready golf to speed up play. Hit-off before marking your scorecard.
- Repair all plug marks on the green, smooth bunkers and repair divots.
- Call on following players if you have lost a ball.
- Observe dress regulations and be neat and tidy in the Clubhouse and on the course.
- Rule Books are available – please get one, put it in your golf bag, use it when unsure of a situation and always advise your marker.
- If unsure whether your marker's ruling is correct or not, you may play 2 balls to finish playing the hole, record both scores; then speak to a Match Committee member prior to submitting your card.
- Ring the Pro-Shop 4648 2387 and let the starter know if you cannot play. Penalty may apply.
- Remember that slow play is selfish play.
- Remember that your place in the field is behind the group in front of you and not in front of the group behind you.

- Do not hit up on the green until all players have retired safely from the green.
- Remember to drive carts and buggies in accordance with directions and signage on the course and use cart paths where provided.

  - Football jumpers, socks or shorts
  - Offensive logos or slogans on clothing
  - Singlets

**Please Note:** All patrons are asked to remove caps, hats or beanies whilst in the Clubhouse



## **APPLICATION OF DRESS REGULATIONS:**

- The Board requires that a suitable standard of dress be observed at all times.
- Members are responsible for the dress of their visitors including children.
- The Club Manager or Operations Manager/Supervisor may object to any dress considered unsuitable.
